He Is Precious!

1 Peter 2:7

How precious is Jesus Christ to you? Why should he be precious to you? Peter gives you four reasons why he is and should be precious to you.

Reason 1: Jesus Christ should be precious to you because of the value his Father places upon him – 1 Peter 2:4

- at his baptism – Matthew 3:17

- at his transfiguration – Matthew 17:5

- at his ascension – Philippians 2:9-11

Reason 2: Jesus Christ should be precious to you because of the value of his death – 1 Peter 1:19

- of more value than perishable gold or silver – 1 Peter 1:18

- the one and only way of redemption – 1 Peter 1:20-21

Reason 3: Jesus Christ should be precious to you because of the value of his life – 1 Peter 2:4-6

- the approved value of his life – 1 Peter 2:4, 1 Corinthians 3:11, Matthew 7:24-25

- the applied value of his life – 1 Peter 2:5-6

Reason 4: Jesus Christ should be precious to you because of the value of his promises – 2 Peter 1:4

- his promises are incomparable – 2 Peter 1:4

- whatever need you have in daily living, he has a precious promise for it that will never fail – 2 Peter 1:3

Nothing that you possess or could possess of this world ... even all of this world combined is comparable to the precious value of the Lord Jesus Christ. How precious is he to you ... right now ... each day?
