

#### February and March Council Report

- The council is very thankful for Rev. Stephen Terpstra's acceptance of our call to be our next pastor. Rev. Terpstra plans to move the end of June with duties beginning July 1 and installation scheduled for July 7. The council greatly appreciates the work of the search committee and for the congregation's support of the council and search committee during our vacancy.
- The council approved an amendment to the church Bylaws to the section on Officers of the Council – B. President – "The regular pastor except during a vacancy" to "The regular pastor or an elder elected annually by the council." (Many churches are having an elder serve as president and a number of pastor candidates the search committee contacted were not president of their council.)
- The Executive committee structure includes the President, Vice President, Clerk, Treasurer, and General Adjunct. The council approved adding the President of the Deacons to the Executive committee.
- The delegates to the classis meeting gave a report. Rev. Jordan Helming was approved by classis to join the Christian Reformed denomination (from the RCA). An installation service is being planned.
- The council approved the membership transfer for Krista Talsma from Almond Valley CRC, Ripon, CA. Welcome Krista to our church.
- Church Order Article 47 was reviewed, which explains the task of synod.
- Committee reports were given. The Guatemala Team auction and meal were well attended.
- The financial reports for January and February 2024 were reviewed.
- Nominations for elders and deacons were made.
