

November Council Report

- The council reviewed the minutes of the September classis meeting held at Immanuel CRC, Orange City. Three congregations in the classis recently received pastors Rev. Cody Statema at Immanuel CRC, Orange City; Rev. Lee Khang at Ocheyedan CRC; and Rev. Aaron Greydanus at First CRC, Hull. Classis passed a classical ministry share of \$115.75 per member. Pastor Jon Keyzer sustained classis' examination for his ordination as a commissioned pastor at Northern Lighthouse Church, Lincoln. Classis requested the churches select a safe church contact Brian Kroeze has agreed to be our church's safe church contact.
- A report on pulpit supply was given. We give thanks for Trevor Mouw's regular pulpit supply over the last ten months and wish him the best as he spends more time with his family. The council greatly appreciates the work of Pastor Jordan Helming in our church as well as other pastors who preach for us.
- Church Order Article 44 was reviewed. A classis may take counsel or joint action with its neighboring classis or classes in matters of mutual concern.
- Committee reports were given. The council appreciates those who filled an Operation Christmas Child box. The council approved the request to have a Christmas tree as a prop for the Christmas program.
- Search committee gave a progress report. The committee continues to make contacts with possible pastors.
- The financial reports for September and October 2023 were reviewed.
