#### **September Council Report**

- The council reviewed some options for the excess fair share funds that will be donated to OCCS as a result of some families qualifying for the Education Savings Accounts. The council approved having these excess funds go towards the curriculum updates.
- The September classis meeting will be held at Immanuel CRC, Orange City. Delegates are Curt Ahrenholz, Mark Kuiken, and Nate Zuiderveen.
- Council approved the Orange City GEMS Club Coordinators' proposal to have GEMS Sunday be held at Immanuel CRC every year with the four CRC pastors rotating giving the message. Reasons having GEMS Sunday at the same location as regular meetings is very helpful for practicing for the service and the girls are familiar with that church.
- Church Order Article 43 was reviewed. Classis shall maintain a student fund and Classical Ministerial Leadership Team to provide support for individuals preparing for ministry in the CRC and classis may grant the right of gifted persons to exhort when the need for their services has been established.
- Committee reports were given. The Youth Group will be presenting a video on their July convention experience on an upcoming Sunday.
