

- The end of June marked the close of the church fiscal year and the first year for Rev. Terpstra serving our church
- Thanks to outgoing council members deacons Leroy De Jager and Ken Timmermans; and elders Doug De Haan, Mark Huizenga, and Bert Reinders for their service and leadership in the church.
- New council members were welcomed and updated at our June meeting – deacons Ed Hoogland and Caleb Pluim; and elders Mike Byker, Rod De Groot, and Kevin Van Donge.
- Office bearers for the new fiscal year are President Doug Schuller, Vice President Brian Kroeze, Clerk Curt Ahrenholz, General Adjunct Kevin Van Donge, Treasurer Phil Kuiken, President of Deacons Nick Noteboom.
- Rev. Terpstra gave an update of Synod. We are thankful for Rev. Terpstra's work at Synod as he served as President of Synod 2025.
- Church Order Articles 62, 63, and 64 were reviewed.
 These included giving both financially and otherwise to develop and sustain ministries of the congregation; ministry to the church's children and youth; and ministry to adult members to equip them to fulfill their calling in the church.
- Committee reports were given. Committees are being updated to replace retiring members. We are thankful for those who are willing to serve.
- The English Standard Version (ESV) pew Bibles have been received and are in use. The council approved donating the old NIV pew Bibles to the Gideons and to One Body One Hope, and also making them available to church members.
- Our church was blessed with the summer seminary internship of Abraham Niranjan who served our church for ten weeks.
- Classical credentials were completed for Classis Heartland meeting scheduled for September 17 at Prairie Lane CRC, Omaha. Approved delegates are Rev. Terpstra and elder Brian Kroeze.
- The council approved a Step into Scripture program for the 2025/2026 church education year.
- The financial reports for May, June, and July 2025 were reviewed.
